

Watering Guidelines:

1st if you have a puddle turn watering time down to put less water on the lawn. Take it down in 3 minute increments until the puddling vanishes within 30 minutes of zone shutting off.

If you have a dry area add time to the sprinklers to add more water to the lawn. Add in increments of 3 minutes on pop-up and 10 minutes on rotor heads until the area is no longer dry, if puddles persist longer than 30 minutes after zone shuts off reduce the time until you have it fine tuned.

Under 70 degrees water every other day, Rotor heads 30 minutes, Pop-up heads 15 min, Swale 10 min

70-80 degrees water every day, Rotor heads 35 min, Pop-ups 20 min, Swale 15 min

Above 80 degrees every day, Rotor heads 45 mins, Pop-up 25 min, Swale 20 min

Remember that shady areas need less water than full sun all day areas.
